I write concerning the qualifications of Doctor Cheryl A. Tickle. She has worked in my laboratory during the last two years as a postdoctoral fellow. She is a highly intelligent person who is deeply serious about her research on cell adhesions. In addition, she is sufficiently independent and motivated to work hard at it on her own. I find her quite critical and reasonably imaginative. This constellation of characters obviously fits her well for a productive and interesting research career and I predict that she will have just that.

I might add that her character and personality are such that she is easy to work with and thus makes a fine collaborator. For all of these reasons she seems to me to be eminently qualified for a post-doctoral fellowship in Professor Adam Curtis' laboratory; I recommend strongly that she be granted one.
