It gives me great pleasure to inform you that, at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the University of Chicago, held Feb. 18 1902 you were promoted to an Asso. Professorship in the Department of Embryology in connection with the faculty in the Quadrant School of Science of the University of Chicago.

The salary will be \$ 2500.<sup>00</sup> per year, to be paid in twelve monthly installments at the end of each month, your term of service to begin October 1<sup>st</sup> 1902

It is understood that the amount of instruction expected of you, in accordance with Section 19 of the Statutes of the University, is two courses during three quarters of the year; but it is further understood that at the discretion of the President, you may be called upon, without additional remuneration, to give three courses of instruction during two quarters of the year.


