

Correction to “Mercury and monomethylmercury in fluids from Sea Cliff submarine hydrothermal field, Gorda Ridge”

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[1] In the paper “Mercury and monomethylmercury in fluids from Sea Cliff submarine hydrothermal field, Gorda Ridge” by C. Lamborg et al. (*Geophysical Research Letters*, 33, L17606, doi:10.1029/2006GL026321, 2006), two reference citations were omitted. The eighth sentence of the last paragraph should read as follows:

[2] It must be noted, however, that deep water datasets [e.g., *Fitzgerald et al.*, 1998; *Laurier et al.*, 2004; *Fitzgerald and Lamborg*, 2004; *Mason and Gill*, 2005] do not indicate

sufficient MMHg concentrations to supply the surface ocean at this rate.

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
